The landscape...

- 22 Local Authorities, 1480 schools
- Devolved government Welsh Government responsible for Education and Health
- The Healthy Eating in Schools (Nutritional Standards and Requirements) (Wales) Regulations 2013
- Welsh Government Free Breakfast Scheme Primary and Y7
- Food and Fun holiday provision



Programme for Government: Cooperation Agreement

- December 2021: Labour and Plaid Cymru to provide Universal Free School Meals to all primary age pupils
- Shared ambition that no child should go hungry, supporting educational attainment, child nutrition, local food production and distribution, benefitting local economies
- 2 year programme starting in September 2022
- Capital Funding
- Unit meal rate £2.90
